Position Description and Information Sheet

Position title: Summer Youth Intern

Position type: Volunteer Internship

Reports to: Director of Youth Ministries

Peñasquitos Lutheran Church (PLC) is looking for four (4) Youth Interns for the summer of 2019. PLC is a congregation of approximately 600 worshippers with an active youth ministry of about 45 teens led by the Youth Director, Youth Mentors, and Youth Board. The interns will serve, lead, teach, mentor, and encourage the youth in their walk with God.

DURATION

The Youth Ministry Internship is for 10 weeks during the months of June, July, and August. Interns will be ministering to young people grades 9-12 and their families, with an emphasis on freshman. Ideally, the internship will begin Monday, June 3, but this is a flexible start date! The volunteer commitment is 30-35 hours per week (with the exception of the 4 Major Summer Events). *Due to the short nature of this internship, time off is limited to one week.* Emergency situations will be dealt with on an individual basis. Normal days off will be Friday and Saturday when youth functions are not scheduled for those days.

RESPONSIBILITIES

This is a volunteer internship with specific benefits including, youth ministry experience, leadership opportunities and training, and personal spiritual development. The interns must attend all High School Ministry events.

It is our goal for the interns to connect with the young people God has entrusted to us in this ministry. Spiritual growth often takes place in the context of a relationship so it is important that the intern spends a lot of time building relationships with students. Ultimately, we hope that these relationships will encourage students to seek God more and grow in their faith.

Female interns will primarily minister to female youth and male interns will primarily minister to the male youth. There will, however, be many occasions this summer where we will all work together, as we emphasize the benefits of collaboration and teamwork in ministry.

SAMPLE WEEK*

Sunday: 9:30-5p Attend church with youth. Go out lunch with youth. Participate in Beach Ministry. Monday: 12-4p Spend time with youth building relationships and leading Bible studies. Tuesday: 4-6p Planning. 6-10p Family Dinner with Interns. Wednesday: 4-10p Planning & Weekly Youth Gathering Thursday: 1-5p Relational time with students Friday and Saturday: Days off *This is an example of a week without major summer events. Volunteer interns will experience the behind the scenes aspects of ministry of activity preparation, coordinating with adult youth volunteers, and administrative duties; and interns will learn how this planning affects and supports quality time with teens developing relationships.

GOAL

To train and equip young adult leaders and give them the opportunity to experience youth ministry from the leadership side.

POLICY

There is one "policy statement" governing youth interns' private lives, and it will be strictly enforced. There will be no new dating relationships within the youth ministry interns and no dating or romantic relationships any high schooler of our youth ministry. All relationships with teens and fellow staff should be above reproach. There are NO exceptions to this policy. Dress, language, behavior, and attitude must be worthy of an ambassador of Jesus Christ.

MAJOR SUMMER EVENTS

- 1. Beach Camp June 24-26
- 2. Hume Lake Summer Camp June 30-July 6
- 3. Vacation Bible School July 24-31 (Mornings)
- 4. Lock-In Saturday, August 3

EXPENSE REIMBURSEMENT

This is a volunteer internship and interns will be reimbursed \$100 a week for expenses.

APPLICATION

The Youth Ministry Internship is a pre-professional opportunity for college students. Those who have been out of high school for at least one year can apply. Applications should be professional, typed, and <u>include a resume</u> and other appropriate supporting data. All applications must be submitted to <u>rhorne@plc-church.org</u> by Sunday, April 7th. Applicants may be contacted for a phone interview in April. We anticipate final decisions and commitments by late April. All applicants will be reviewed by a committee consisting of youth workers and church leaders.
